



How It Works



Goal

Welcome to LibrariaQuest! You are exploring the Land of Libraria on a Quest to find Seven Lost Treasures & the Tomb of the First Queen of Libraria. You will travel along the Quest Path on your Journey Map, moving forward a space for each Reading Log you submit, each Teen Program you attend, & each Hour you Volunteer at the library. As you submit Reading Logs or visit the library for programs or volunteering, check with a **library staff member** to have them **initial** the next circle on your Quest Path.

You will find one of the Lost Treasures each time you reach a numbered red circle on your Journey Map. When you earn a Treasure, a library staff member will give you the corresponding Treasure Card with the next part of the Story of your Quest. The next time you visit the library, you will be able to pick up a Prize for the Treasure you earned.

If you lose or forget your Journey Map, don't worry! We will track your progress separately, so check in with Amanda, the Teen Programmer, to update your progress (aanderson@wclibrarytn.org).

Prizes & Rewards

You will earn a 3D Printed Treasure for each Lost Treasure you reach on your Journey Map by January 12. You can earn plenty of these prizes without completing the entire Quest! We will recognize everyone who completes the entire Quest at our Finale Party on January 12 at Jonesborough Library. We will also give Top Reader Awards, so keep submitting reading logs even after you complete the Quest!

Teen Programs

Teen Programs will be held at both libraries throughout November, December, & January. Each program you attend allows you to progress a space on your Quest Path, so don't forget to bring your Journey Map when you come to a program! See the back of this booklet for a schedule of the programs that are part of the Winter Reading Challenge.

Reading Logs

You can submit a Reading Log for each 100 pages you read beginning November 12. Reading Logs may be submitted at either library or online. To submit a Reading Log at the library, bring it to a library staff member with your Journey Map. The staff member will initial the next circle on your Quest Path & take your log.

You can also submit Reading Logs on our website, wclibrarytn.org. If you submit logs online, you will need to check in with Amanda to get your Journey Map updated.

Each Reading Log covers 100 pages of reading, divided into 20 page increments. If you want to divide your reading into different increments of pages, that's fine, as long as 100 total pages are recorded on your log.

Reading Logs must be submitted by January 12 to earn Treasures & by January 9 for Top Reader Awards.

Volunteering

Each hour you volunteer at the library from November 12 to January 12 will let you advance a space on your Journey Map. Teen Advisory Group meetings count as volunteering, & there will also be a volunteer opportunity in Jonesborough on December 8. If you are interested in helping clean or shelve books at the library on a more regular basis, check with a library staff member to get a Volunteer Application.

Other Ways to Advance

If you have an idea for another way you want to advance on the Quest Path, such as writing a story or book reviews, check in with Amanda & we can work something out!
