



How It Works



Goal

Welcome to the Teen Winter Reading Challenge! You are exploring the Biblio Seas on an adventure to find buried treasure. You will follow your Treasure Map, moving forward one space for each Reading Log you submit, each Teen Program you attend, & each Hour you Volunteer at the library. As you submit Reading Logs or visit the library for programs or volunteering, check with a **library staff member** to have them **initial** the next circle on your Treasure Map.

You will earn a prize each time you reach a numbered red circle on your Treasure Map. After you reach a prize milestone, check back in at the desk next time you are at the library to pick up your reward!

If you submit reading logs online, or if you lose or forget your Treasure Map, don't worry! We will track your progress separately, so check in with Amanda, the Teen Programmer, to update your map and collect any prizes you've earned (aanderson@wclibrarytn.org).

Teen Programs

Teen Programs will be held at both libraries throughout November, December, & January. Each program you attend allows you to progress a space on your Treasure Map, so don't forget to bring your map when you come to a program! See the back of this booklet for a schedule of the programs that will help you progress as part of the Winter Reading Challenge.

Reading Logs

You can submit a Reading Log for each 100 pages you read beginning November 18. Reading Logs may be submitted at either library or online. To submit a Reading Log at the library, bring it to a library staff member with your Treasure Map. The staff member will initial the next box on your map & take your log.

You can also submit Reading Logs on our website, wclibrarytn.org. If you submit logs online, you will need to check in with Amanda to get your Journey Map updated.

Each Reading Log covers 100 pages of reading, divided into 20 page increments. If you want to divide your reading into different increments of pages, that's fine, as long as 100 total pages are recorded on your log.

Reading Logs must be submitted by January 11 to earn prizes & by January 9 for Top Reader Awards.

Volunteering

Each hour you volunteer at the library from November 18 to January 11 will let you advance a space on your Treasure Map. There will be a volunteer opportunity in Jonesborough on December 14, and if you are interested in helping clean or shelve books at the library, check in with a library staff member to get a Volunteer Application.

Other Ways to Advance

If you have an idea for another way you want to advance on the map, such as writing a story or book reviews, check in with Amanda & we can decide what is fair!

Prizes & Rewards

You will earn a 3D-printed prize for each milestone you reach on your Treasure Map by January 11. You can earn plenty of prizes without needing to complete the entire map! Everyone who does reach the buried treasure marked with a red "x" will be recognized at our Escape Room/Finale Party on January 11 at Jonesborough Library. We will also give Top Reader Awards, so keep submitting reading logs even after you complete the Map!

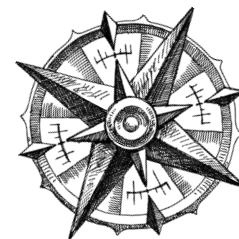
