## *What is a Fractured Fairy Tale?*

A Fractured Fairy Tale is a retelling of a classic fairy tale, with some sort of twist added. It explores the original tale from a different angle, changing it by exploring a "what if" question to make an original story. Sometimes the twist in a Fractured Fairy Tale makes the story darker or changes the happy ending, but the story doesn't have to be darker and grittier unless you want it to be!

*Choose your Twist: Come up with a "What If" for your story!* For example:

- ◇ Tell the story from a different character's perspective! What about a minor character's perspective? Or the villain's?
- ◇ What if an event in the original story turns out differently? How does the tale change? For example, what if the miller's daughter kept her promise to Rumpelstiltskin?
- ◇ What if a character from the original story has a different personality? For example, what if the Evil Queen is actually good, and it's Snow White who is the villain?
- ◇ Change the setting! What if the fairy tale happens in the modern day, or the future?
- ◇ Change the ending! What if there isn't a happily ever after, or the happily ever after turns out differently? Or write about happens after the original fairy tale ends!

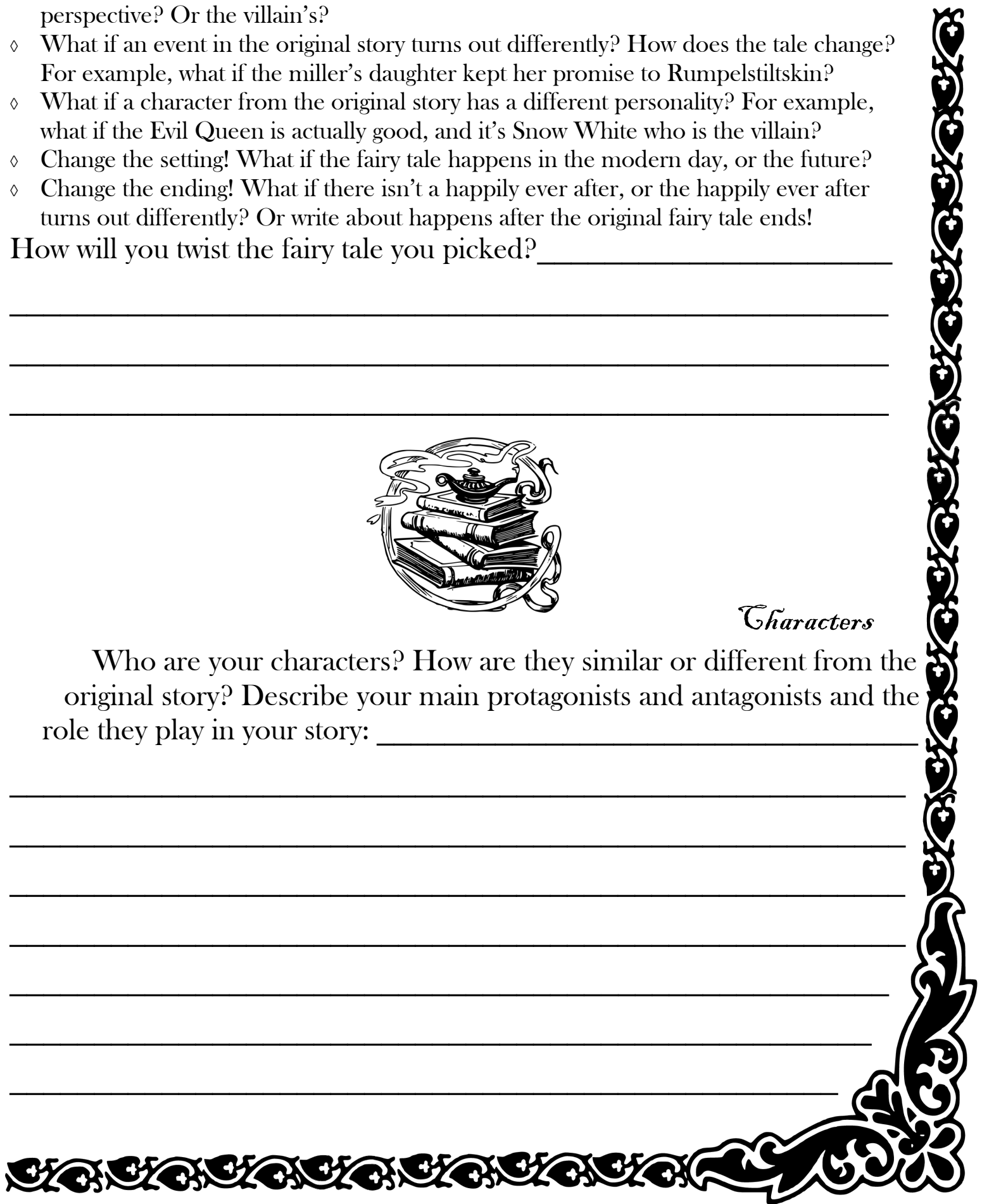

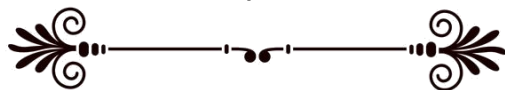
